Amend petition – Solicitor Journey

To begin the amend petition process, you will need to confirm you wish to submit an amended application. In the 'next step' drop down actions you will need to select 'submit amended application' and press continue the below screen will then be presented which you will need to select continue and then submit:

When you start an amended application, the old divorce case will be stopped and a new case will be created. To access the new case go to the 'Linked cases' tab, click on the link to the new case and then select the next step 'Amend divorce application'.
