### Purpose

- 1. The purpose of this instruction is to notify all Governors and Directors of the mandatory requirement to inform Identity and Passport Service (IPS) of the actual release date of a prisoner who is subject to a Travel Restriction Order.
- 2. This Instruction requires Governors and Directors to notify the Immigration Service when a foreign national who is subject to a Travel Restriction Order (TRO) is due to be deported, released or transferred to an immigration centre.
- 3. It requires all UK passports in possession of those prisoners who are subject to TROs to be sent to IPS.

### Policy and output

- 4. Section 33-37 of the Criminal Justice Act 2001 allows the courts to impose TROs on drug trafficking offenders who are sentenced to 4 years or more and to confiscate the passports of British nationals for the period of the travel ban.
- 5. To facilitate the implementation of this legislation IPS must be notified to ensure that they know when a travel restriction order comes into effect and when it is due to expire.

6. Governors and Directors must put in place a procedure to ensure compliance with the legislation that includes the following steps:

- I. All prisoners subject to Travel Restriction Orders are identified on reception into the prison, recorded on LIDS/C NOMIS and the order placed on the warrant file within 2 working days of reception.
- II. UK passports received into custody in the possession of a prisoner who is subject to a Travel Restriction Order are sent to IPS. The contact details are set out at Annex A
- III. The Identity and Passport Service is notified no later than two weeks in advance of the actual release date of a prisoner who is subject to a Travel Restriction Order, or immediately where a prisoner is released at short notice. The notification template is set out at <u>Annex B</u>
- IV. The Immigration Service is notified of the imminent movement of foreign nationals who are subject to Travel Restriction Orders. The contact details are set out at <u>Annex C</u>.

#### Implementation

7. This PSI must be implemented immediately.

# Mandatory action

8. Governors and Directors must ensure that the contents of this Instruction are brought to the immediate attention of all relevant staff.

### **Resource Implications**

9. Implementation of this PSI has limited resource implications for data entry and notification but should be met from within existing resources.
