





LIVING IN PORTUGAL?

REGISTER NOW!

If you are living in Portugal, here is what you need to know about becoming a resident:

You are required to register for residence with the Portuguese authorities

You can register from the day you arrive in Portugal

Go to your Town Hall (Câmara Municipal) to register by 31 December 2020

You need to take your valid Passport, proof of address, and proof you have means to support yourself and your family

You will be asked to sign a sworn statement declaring you have sufficient means of subsistence for you and your family

The Town Hall will issue you with a residence document valid for 5 years

If you are a UK national living in Portugal or arriving here until 31 December 2020, you will continue to have your rights protected after the end of the transition period.
