# JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claim of unfair dismissal is successful and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £500
- 2. The claimant's claim for a redundancy payment is successful and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £1270
- 3. The claimant's claims for unauthorised deductions from wages is successful and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £4134.56
- 4. The claimant's claim for breach of contract is successful and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £3160.40

All sums referred to are gross (without deductions for tax or national insurance) and the claimant will be required to account for any tax or national insurance owed as a result of payments made under this judgment.
