# **JUDGMENT**

## It is the judgment of the Tribunal that:

- 1. The claim for unpaid wages fails and is dismissed.
- 2. The holiday pay claim succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £727.50.
- 3. When the proceedings were begun the Respondent was in breach of its duty to the Claimant under section 1(1) of the Employment Rights Act 1996 to give a written statement of initial employment particulars. Pursuant to s.38 of the Employment Act 2002, the Claimant is awarded £450.
