We refer to your email dated 8 June 2020 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the same date.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

“Could I please request the following for the time period 26th March 2020 to June 1st 2020.

- 1. Fixed penalty notices issued under emergency COVID regulations, separated into ethnicity and age.**
- 2. The number of people issued fixed penalty notices under COVID regulations, separated by ethnicity and age.**
- 3. Arrests under emergency COVID regulations, separated into ethnicity and age.**
- 4. The number of people arrested under COVID regulations, separated into ethnicity and age.”**

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
