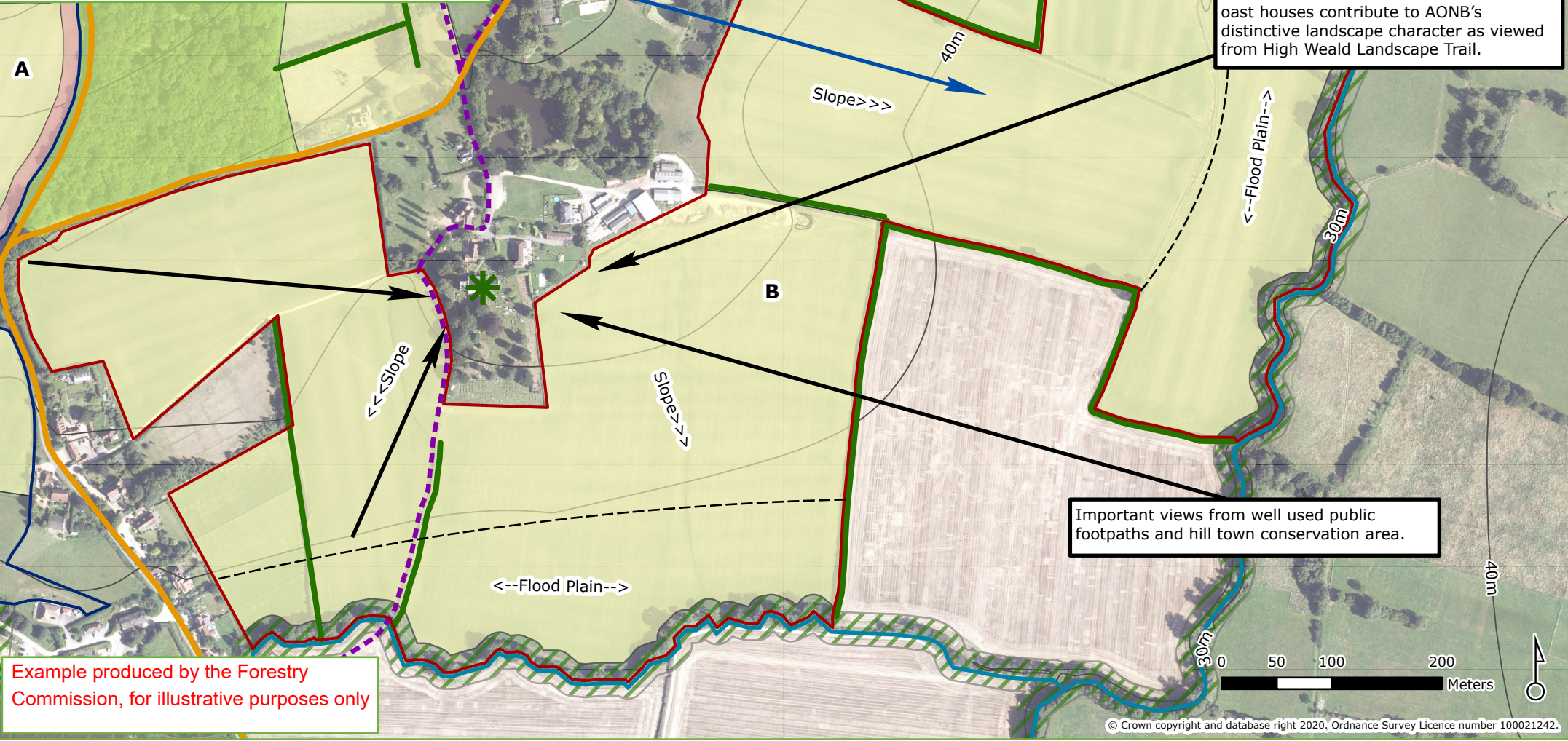

**Zone B**  
 Open landscape on sloping farmland with high degree of public visibility. The distinctive ancient church and oast houses on prominent landform are within the setting of a local conservation area and can be seen throughout the site and from the wider countryside and are key to a strong spirit of place.

River Catchment: water quality and quantity sensitive

Distinctive view of the church hamlet and oast houses contribute to AONB's distinctive landscape character as viewed from High Weald Landscape Trail.
