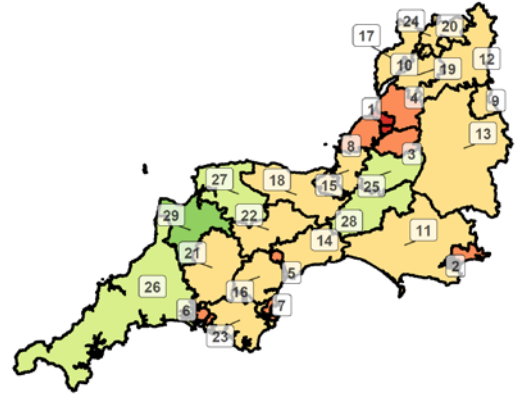

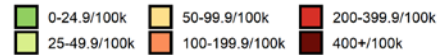

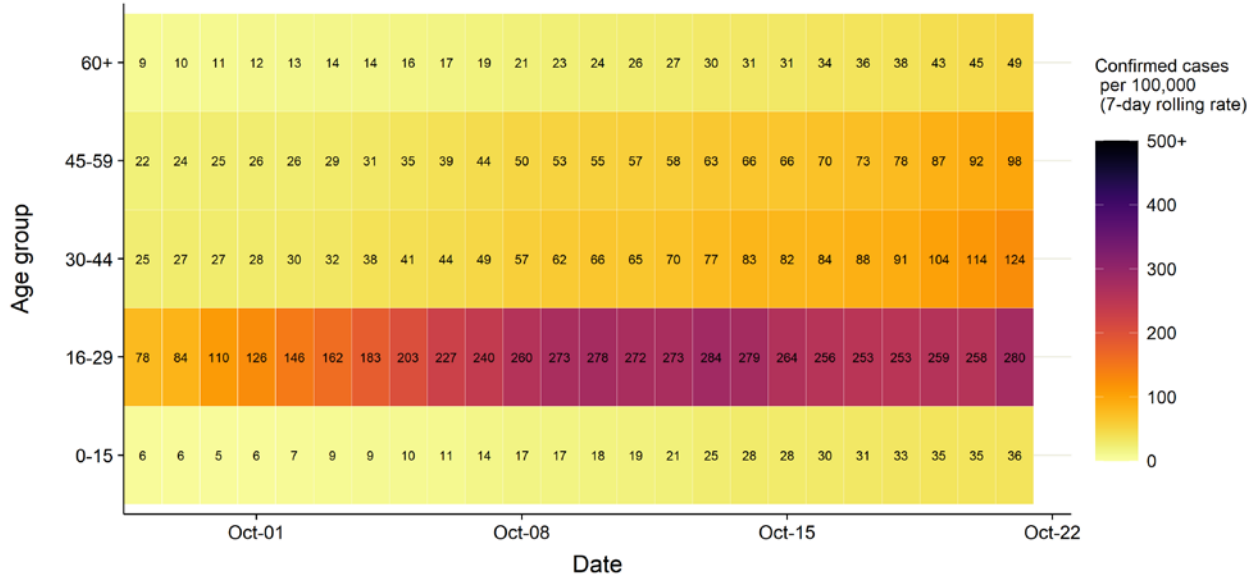
Covid-19 rate by local authority
