## JUDGMENT ON A PRELIMINARY HEARING

- 1. The claims of detriment for making a protected disclosure were not brought within time and it was reasonably practicable to bring those claims within time. These claims are struck out.
- 2. The claims for direct discrimination and harassment on grounds of race are to proceed to the full hearing as the claimant has shown a prima facie case that the complaints are capable of being an act extending over a period.
