JUDGMENT

1. The Judgment of the Tribunal is that the Claimant's complaints are not well founded, and the claim is dismissed.
2. However, the Claimant maintains, and the Respondent agrees, that due to what the Respondent says is a clerical error, the Claimant was not paid the sum of £402.73 by way of outstanding pension contributions which should have been part of his payment in lieu of notice.
3. The Respondent has agreed that it will pay that sum to the Claimant within 21 days of the Claimant providing to the Respondent's Solicitors the details of the bank account into which that sum is to be paid.
