A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request. However some of the information requested has been withheld by virtue of the following exemptions:

Section 26 – Defence

Section 31 – Law Enforcement

Section 43 – Commercial Interests

Section 26, 31 and 43 are qualified exemptions and are subject to public interest testing which means that the information requested can only be withheld if the public interest in doing so outweighs the public interest in disclosure.

Section 26 – Defence has been applied because although there is presumption of release under FOI, the release of exact contract end dates, extension periods and break clauses would provide valuable information to those wishing to circumvent our security systems, meaning that we would fail in our duty to help prevent criminal activity which in turn would fail in our duty to assist those services providing us with law enforcement. Additionally, in respect of information relating to control rooms, this is exempt because the information in scope of your request would assist those with criminal intent to assess any weaknesses in the operational function of control rooms. Providing the location, operational manning levels and other details relating to force control rooms would potentially jeopardise the function of the MDP across the defence estate by providing intelligence to cause disruption or prevention of the policing duty at specific MDP locations and create a security vulnerability that could be exploited.

Section 31 – Law Enforcement has been applied because although the public are entitled to know how public funds are spent, to release detailed operational information in relation to force control rooms may impact negatively on the law enforcement provided by the Ministry of Defence Police across the defence estate. By providing such sensitive information to those with criminal intent, this may identify vulnerabilities across the force and therefore place Ministry of Defence Police officers under an increased policing burden and risk the prevention and detection of crime.

Section 43 – Commercial Interests has been applied because although transparency with regard to public spending is favourable, the release of this information would disadvantage the MOD's negotiating position and would remove its commercial leverage to attain best value for money to the taxpayer.
