JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is well founded and succeeds
- 2. Polkey applies to the extent of 100%
- 3. The claimant contributed to his own dismissal by his culpable and blameworthy conduct to the extent of 100%
- 4. The claimant's claim for payment in lieu of holiday accrued but not taken at the date of dismissal is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 5. The claimant's claim that he was not issued with a written statement of employment particulars is not well founded.
- 6. The respondent was entitled to dismiss the claimant without notice or payment in lieu of notice and his claim of wrongful dismissal is not well founded and is dismissed.
