We are writing to you to highlight two important milestones on the journey towards a fitting and lasting memorial for the Grenfell Tower site.

We understand the importance of the site to you and all of the community and have been clear that the bereaved, survivors and community will be at the heart of decisions around the long-term future of the site. The work to establish the Grenfell Tower Memorial Commission is under way and we are pleased that so many of the bereaved, survivors and residents have participated in the process to choose community representatives in recent weeks. Whilst the deadline for voting was 12 July, the website and your voting codes will remain active until 21 July. If you have not had the chance to vote, we would encourage you to be a part of this important process. In August 2018 the Government committed to take responsibility for the site until the long-term future has been determined by the community. This process is now complete which means that the Government is responsible for making day to day decisions in relation to the site, such as on the site's safety and security. This will ensure that RBKC takes no role in decisions about the operational management of the site. We are committed to ensuring that you are kept regularly updated on our management of the site and engaged with any operational decisions. If you have any
