




Age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate for West Midlands : 12 Oct to 04 Nov 2020










Daily cases, persons tested and positivity, Cannock Chase : 01 June to 08 Nov 2020




Daily cases, persons tested and positivity, Coventry: 01 June to 08 Nov 2020




Daily cases, persons tested and positivity, Dudley : 01 June to 08 Nov 2020










Daily cases, persons tested and positivity, Sandwell : 01 June to 08 Nov 2020




Daily cases, persons tested and positivity, Solihull : 01 June to 08 Nov 2020




Daily cases, persons tested and positivity, South Staffordshire : 01 June to 08 Nov 2020






Daily cases, persons tested and positivity, Staffordshire Moorlands: 01 June to 08 Nov 2020








