JUDGMENT

- (1) The Claimant's claim was presented out of time.
- (2) It was reasonably practicable to bring the claim in time and time is not extended for the complaint of unlawful deduction from wages, which is therefore struck out.
- (3) Time for presenting the claim (in relation to whether the dismissal was an act of race discrimination) is extended pursuant to the Tribunal's just and equitable discretion.
- (4) In relation to the race discrimination complaints, there is no finding as to whether other complaints about the conduct alleged are in time (whether individually or as part of a continuing act) or whether time should be extended if not; that is a matter for the full Hearing.
