- 3. The claimant's claim for failure to pay wages (to which he is legally entitled under s.1 National Minimum Wage Act 1998) under s.13 Employment Rights Act 1996 is well founded and the respondents should pay the claimant £38,025.46;
- 4. The recoupment provisions apply to this judgment.
