JUDGMENT

1. The Claim for unauthorised deductions from wages is well-founded and the Respondent shall pay to the Claimant the sum of £2,077.44, gross.
2. The claim for holiday pay is well-founded and the Respondent shall pay to the Claimant the sum of £425.46, gross.
3. The total of these sums is £2,502.90.

REASONS

1. The Claimant set out her claim to me at this hearing conducted via CVP video link and verified it in the short evidence she gave on affirmation.
2. The calculation for unpaid wages is for 21 days at £134.64 per day, gross. This is £2,827.44. Credit is given for £750 that has been paid, which leaves £2,077.44. The holiday pay owed is 4.33 days at the daily rate (£582.99) against which the Claimant gives credit for 1.17 days (£157.53). This produces £425.46.
