Thank you for your email of 20 October 2020 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requesting the following information:

"I would appreciate it if could inform me of the medal entitlement of the following soldier:

1566999 George Gibson Stuart, Royal Artillery. He died in September 1944 whilst on active service"

A search for the information has now been completed within the MOD and I can confirm all information in scope of your request is held.

I can confirm that Lance Bombardier George Gibson Stuart was awarded the 1939-45 Star, the Atlantic Star and the War Medal. All medals were issued on 19 November 1949.
