Introduce a new code 24A – child criminal exploitation.

# Reason for change (including benefits)

Recording and collating data on child criminal exploitation in the 2021 to 2022 CIN census and beyond will enable DfE to estimate the scale of this exploitation for the first time. In the longer term, it will help it to identify whether there is a decline or increase in the prevalence of child criminal exploitation.

Collecting and publishing this data will support future child criminal exploitation policy development.
