a) I have received a written declaration from the owner/exporter\* stating that the ferret has been kept in captivity in the United Kingdom or South Africa for the last 6 months prior to export or since birth;

I have confirmed the identity of the ferret by reading the implanted b) microchip transponder;

- to the best of my knowledge and belief and as far as it is possible to c) determine, the ferret has not been in contact with any animal infected or suspected of being infected with rabies;
- d) the ferret originate from an area which is not under any official restrictions due to any notifiable disease to which carnivores are susceptible;
- the United Kingdom is officially free of rabies according to the rules e) of the World Organisation for Animal Health(OIE), Terrestrial Animal Health Code;

- I have received a written declaration from the owner/exporter\* stating that the ferret will be shipped in a container which conforms to IATA regulations, and which is either new or has been suitably disinfected and fumigated before loading and is of such a nature that contact with other animals of a lesser health status en route will be prevented. j)
