The route then proceeds generally south south east for 690 metres to terminate at the junction with existing Public Footpath RZ8 at NGR SP7393 4893 point C on the Order Map.

The claimed route has a width which varies between 2.9 metres and 3.5 metres.

As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 10 March 2021]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.


