This is due to the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Council of the City of York hereby order that:

- 1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 10 January 2020.
