




MITIGATION: RAVENSHAW WOOD



- Earthwork depicted on historic maps known as 'Kingstanding' excavated (c.40m in diameter E-W and N-S).
- Small assemblage of Roman pottery recovered from the ditch.
- A fragment of a quern stone was recovered from the south-east quadrant of the feature.
- No archaeological remains in internal area of ring ditch.
- Four pits of N-S alignment N-W of ring ditch. No archaeological finds.

MITIGATION: PACKINGTON MOOR



- Romano-British field systems
- Likely to representative of outer most part of nearby Romano-British farmstead.
- Site activity appears to have continued up to the post-medieval era.
- Substantial ceramic collection retrieved from southern features.






MITIGATION: COLESHILL



- Roman Brooch and coin, a late medieval coin, post med and modern finds, from metal detecting.
- Two Burnt mounds
- Two palaeochannels
- Four pit alignments. Two more are expected.
- Iron Age roundhouses (x2).
- Cremation cemetery, c.10 20 total.
- Iron Age/Romano-British enclosure and field system ditches. Two of the ditches follow and truncate earlier pit alignments.
- Small rectangular enclosure overlooks the River Cole and cuts one of the pit alignments.




