## **JUDGMENT**

## **REASONS**

- 1. The claimant has already received a judgement striking out her unfair dismissal claim on the basis that she does not have two years' service with the respondent company and consequently the tribunal had no jurisdiction to deal with that claim.
- 2. The hearing this morning was to establish what other claims the claimant has. The claimant did not attend the hearing on the telephone. Mr Griffiths, representing the respondents, did.

3. On the face of the claimant's claim form there are no other issues to be dealt with and consequently I dismissed all claims, whatever they may be. This litigation stops with this judgment.
