

## Full Surrender

---

We have decided to accept the surrender of the permit for Nafferton Wold Egg Unit operated by Nafferton Wold Farms Limited.

The permit number is EPR/EP3538CV/S004.

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state. We consider in reaching this decision that we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

### Purpose of this document

This decision document provides a record of the decision making process. It summarises the decision-making process to show how the main relevant factors have been taken into account.

### Decision considerations

Nafferton Wold Farms Limited have applied to surrender their permit. They have decommissioned their Colony Cage Egg Building and converting their Barn Egg Production to Free Range Egg Production – a process which has taken them from 84,000 bird places to 32,000 free range bird places for laying hens – and therefore below the permitting threshold of 40,000.

### Confidential and Identifying confidential information

A claim for commercial or industrial confidentiality has not been made. The decision was taken in accordance with our guidance on confidentiality. We have not identified information provided as part of the application that we consider to be confidential. The decision was taken in accordance with our guidance on confidentiality.

### Pollution risk

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid a pollution risk resulting from the operation of the regulated facility.

### Satisfactory state

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to return the site of the regulated facility to a satisfactory state, having regard to the state of the site before the facility was put into operation.
