# **Information on Frozen Beef for Processing Quota under Commission Regulation (EC) No. 412/2008**

### **Introduction**

The UK has left the EU and the transition period will end on 31 December 2020.

To prepare your business for the end of the transition period please visit [www.gov.uk/transition](http://www.gov.uk/transition)

### **Management of the Frozen Beef for Processing Quota from 1 January 2021**

Order numbers 09.4057 and 09.4058 are currently licence managed quotas, however these quotas will be moving to First Come First Served (FCFS) management from 1 January 2021. From this date onwards you will not need an import licence and you should apply to Customs to import under these quotas. If you have a licence which is still valid at 1 January 2021, this will be cancelled and your security will be released.

The new UK order numbers will be:

05.0144 for A product; and  
05.0145 for B product.

### **Import rights**

For import rights allocated in sub periods 1 and 2 of the quota year starting 1 July 2020:

- if you wish to import during the remainder of 2020, you should apply to RPA as usual for your import licence;
- for any import rights not converted to a licence by the end of 2020, these will no longer be required and your security will be released.
