RULE 21 JUDGMENT

MADE PURSUANT TO RULE 21 OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNALS RULES OF PROCEDURE 2013

- 1. The claimant's claim for damages for breach of contract (notice pay) succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £2,520.00 (8 weeks @ £315per week).
- 2. The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £1882.50. This is the gross amount. If the respondent pays the tax and national insurance due to HMRC, payment of the net amount will meet the judgment debt.
- 3. The respondent failed to pay the claimant in lieu of entitlement to annual leave. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £3,300.00.
- 4. The claimant was unfair dismissed.
- 5. The claim will be listed for a remedy hearing, on a date to be notified to the to parties, to determine what compensation the claimant is entitled to receive in respect of unfair dismissal. A time allocation of 1 hour will be given for the hearing.
