The High Speed (West Midlands to Crewe) Bill

The High Speed (West Midlands to Crewe) Bill - House of Lords

- The Select Committee considering the 36 petitions against the Bill in the House of Lords held virtual hearings in July and virtual/hybrid hearings in September, and is expected to complete its public hearings on 23 September.
- Full details of the Select Committee can be found on their website here.
- Of the 36 petitions submitted against the Bill, just 15 (42%) appeared before the Select Committee, we having settled with the remainder or they having decided not to appear or to withdraw their petition.
- After its last public hearing the Select Committee will meet in private as necessary to deliberate and then
 publish a report with their recommendations. At that point, the Select Committee will formally have
 finished its work.
- The Bill will then continue through its remaining 'normal' public Bill stages in the House of Lords Grand Committee, Report and Third Reading*.
- The Government will respond to the Select Committee report in due course, in advance of Third Reading.
- Royal Assent is expected in late 2020*

- Note: No Schedule 17 submission cab be submitted, until a programme of consents / information is
 provided to the local authority. This is a requirement to the Bill and in the Planning Memorandum,
 which states under paragraph 1.1.7 "The nominated undertaker will work with qualifying authorities
 to support the determination of requests for approval, which will include early and constructive
 engagement, in accordance with obligations set out in this Memorandum".
