FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: BYLAW OFFENCES AT HMNB PORTSMOUTH.

We refer to your email dated 15 October 2020 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the same date.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following follow on information:

"For each calendar year between 2016-2019, and between January 1 and October 15 in 2020, please provide the following:

- 1. How many offences have you recorded under the HM Naval Base Portsmouth byelaws 1981?
- 2. How many arrests were made under the byelaws?
- 3. How many people were prosecuted?

If possible please breakdown the types of offences in each question above.

If this is not possible, please answer the first three questions but also:

How many offences were recorded under section 3 (3) - No person shall drive, attempt to drive or be in charge of a bicycle, tricycle or motor vehicle on any such road when unfit through drink or drugs.

How many arrests were made under section 3(3)?

How many people were prosecuted under section 3(3)?"

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
