## JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

## REASONS

- 1. Rule 37 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013 gives tribunals the power to strike out a claim that has not been actively pursued.
- 2. By letter dated 2 November 2020 the tribunal indicated that the claimant appeared not to have been pursuing his claim and that it was at risk of being struck out. The letter gave the claimant the opportunity to make representations in writing or to request a hearing.
- 3. The claimant replied on 3 November 2020 stating, "...let sleeping dogs lay" and "You won't be hearing from me again so close the case if you want to..."
- 4. The claim is therefore struck out.
