DECISION ON RECONSIDERATION

The Claimant's application (undated) for reconsideration and review of the Tribunal's Judgment on Preliminary Issue and Deposit Order, sent to the parties on 10 February 2020 is refused.

REASONS

- 1. The application is lengthy and discursive and focuses largely on the claimant's perception of the conduct of the hearing rather than the substance of the decision. This was a lengthy hearing and time was taken to consider the claimant's arguments, and allowances made for her disabilities and those of her lay representative.
- 2. The Tribunal has set out its conclusions in its detailed PH judgment and Deposit Order and the matters set out in the reconsideration application do not disclose any arguable basis to reconsider the judgment or Order in the interests of justice. In the circumstances, there are no reasonable prospects of the original decision being varied or revoked.
- 3. The application for reconsideration is refused.
