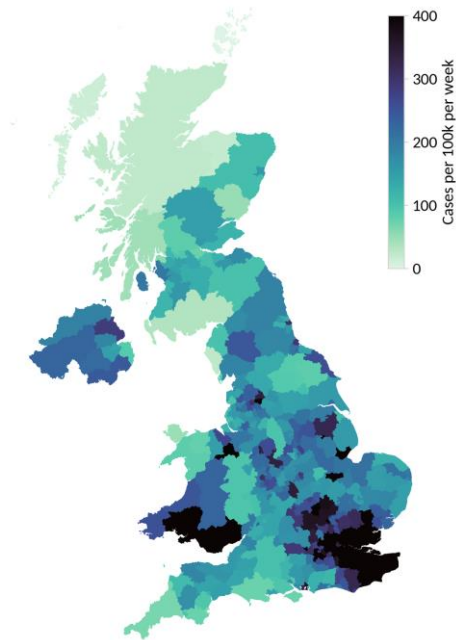
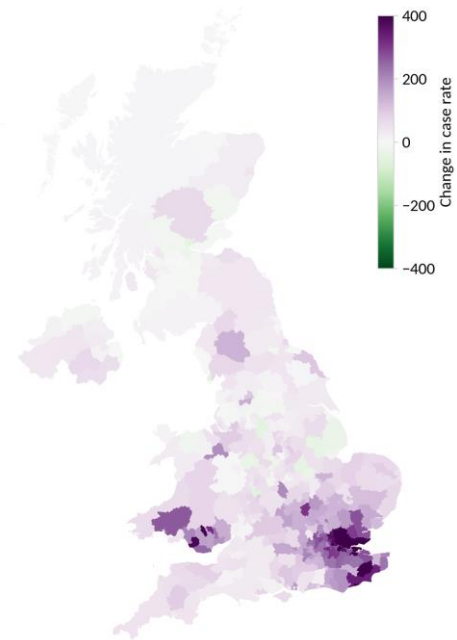


Over the last seven days UK case-rates have continued to rise at a rapid pace, particularly in London, the South-East and East of England, and Wales.

Case-rates 17 December

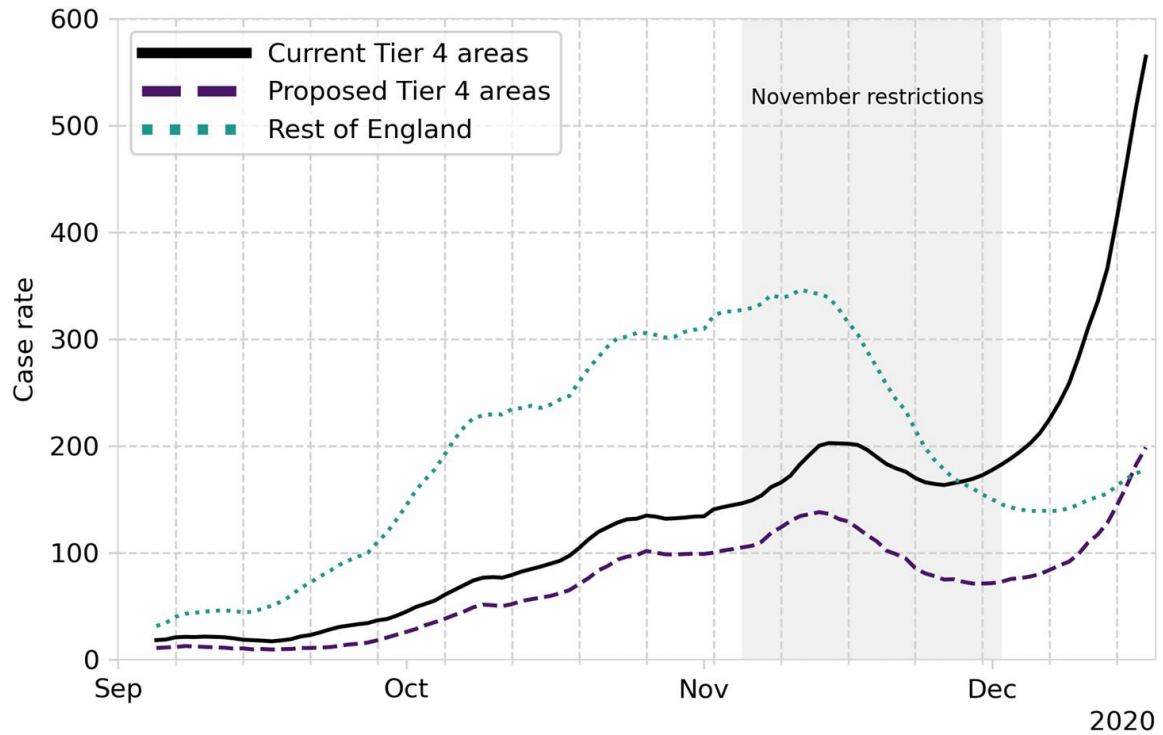


Change in case-rate since 10 December



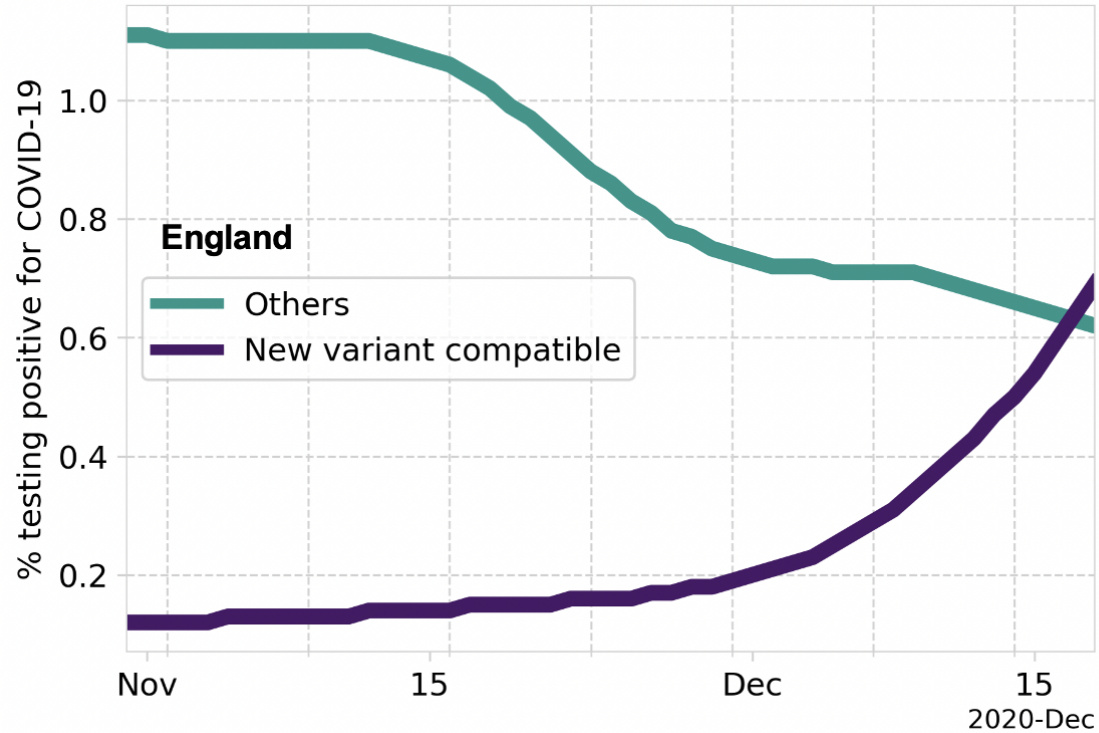
Case-rates are the number of positive tests per 100,000 resident population per week.

Case rates in areas moving to Tier 4 follow trajectory of existing Tier 4 area case-rates



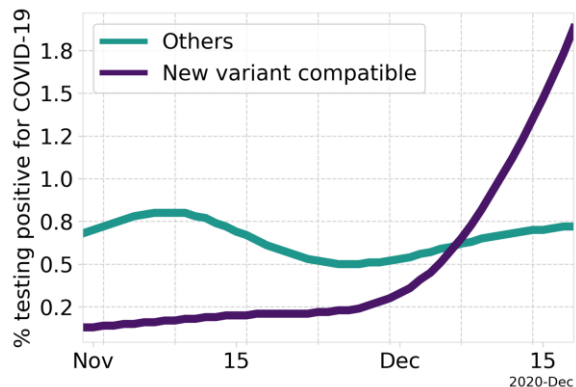

The new variant is growing more quickly than others and has been identified across the country

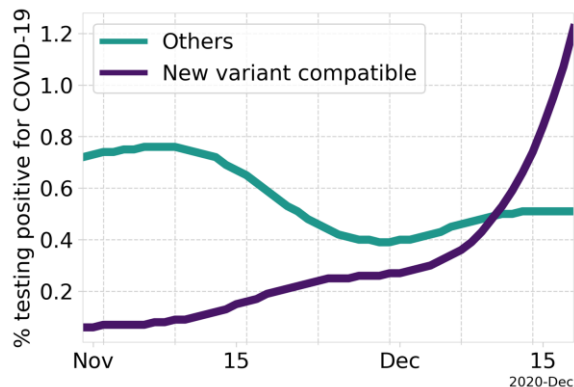


The new variant is growing fastest in London, the South East and East

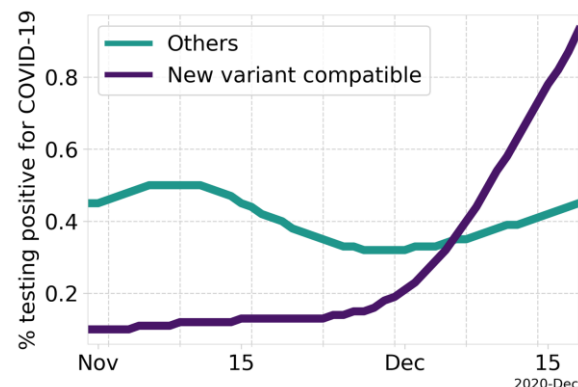

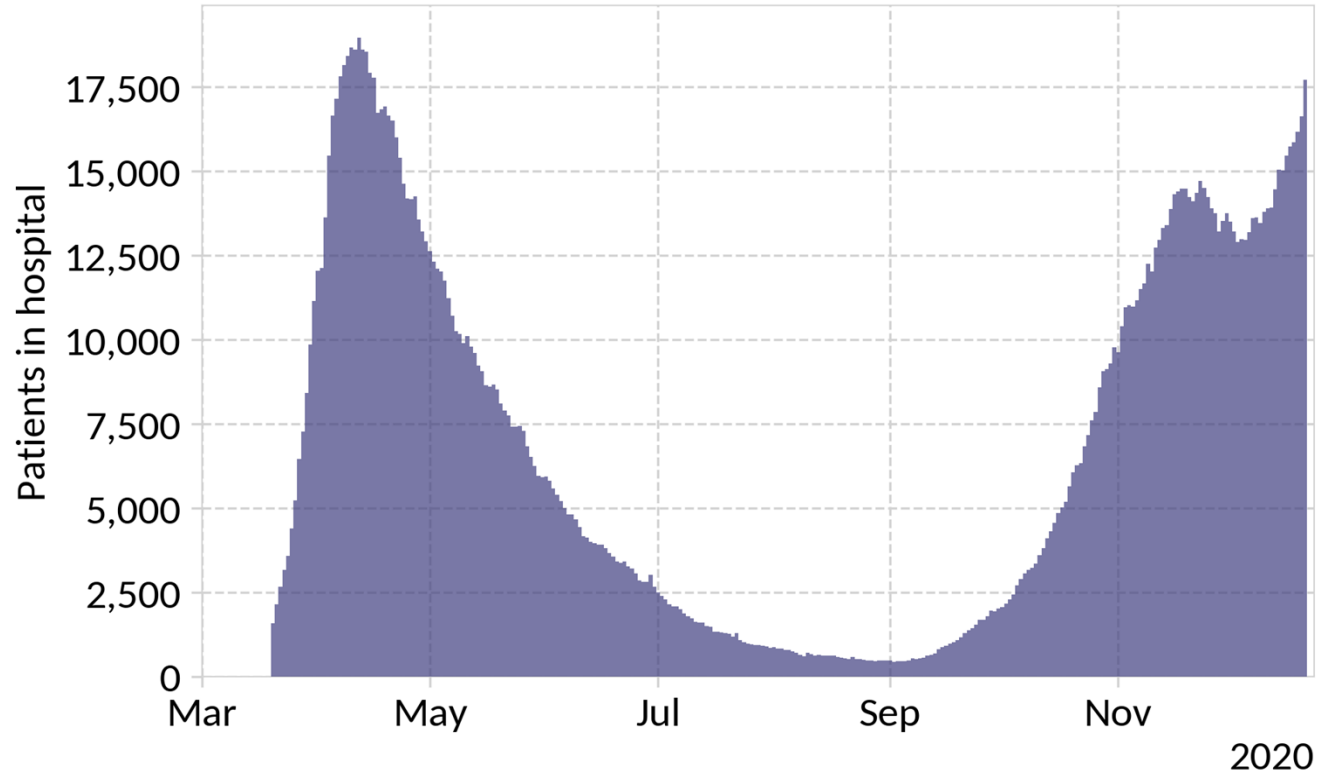
