## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000. MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: BODY WORN CAMERAS.

We refer to your e-mail of 21 August 2020, which was acknowledged on 24 August 2020.

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

**“When I say as BWC been using in court your answer was 19, is this military or civilian court please?”**

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

Body Worn Video footage was supplied to the Crown Prosecution Service as part of the court file on 18 occasions and on 1 occasion was submitted to the Coroners Court. It is not known whether it was actually used in the courts as part of the evidence presented. None have been supplied to a Court Martial.
