JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The Claimant's claim of unfair dismissal is struck out, the Tribunal having no jurisdiction to hear his complaint, it having been determined that the Claimant's complaint was presented outside the time limit imposed by s.111(2) Employment Rights Act 1996, and that it was reasonably practicable to present the claim within the primary time limit.
- 2. The claimant's claims of race discrimination and victimisation are not well founded and are dismissed.
