Please confirm to me whether there is any post 92,000 Kilo Hertz transmission enough to be a form of "illegal broadcast" at least here within little backwater "Taunton" where the yokels live

In response to your queries, I have completed a search for the information within the Defence Electronics & Components Agency (DECA), and I can confirm that **we do not hold information in scope of your request.**

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has ended.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process is complete.
