

Age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate for North East: 14 Dec to 06 Jan 2021






Age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority for North East: 14 Dec to 06 Jan 2021






Regional case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, North East: 01 Oct to 10 Jan 2021






















