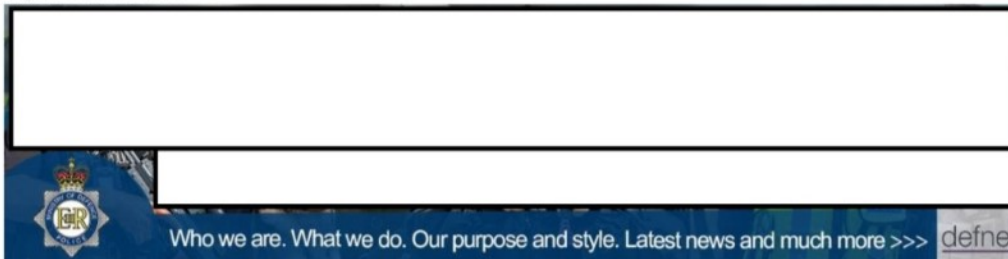
Please note that any request for an internal review should be made within 40 working days of the date of this response.
