JUDGMENT

The Claimant was subject to an unlawful deduction from wages.

The Respondent shall pay to the Claimant the sum of £960.50 comprising of:

- (a) Unlawful deduction from wages between 19th January and 22nd February 2019 of £386.75;
- (b) Unlawful deduction from wages of 23rd February to 27th February 20 of £233.75
- (c) Payment of £340.00 for accrued but untaken holiday for the period 22nd December 2019 until 27th January 2020.
