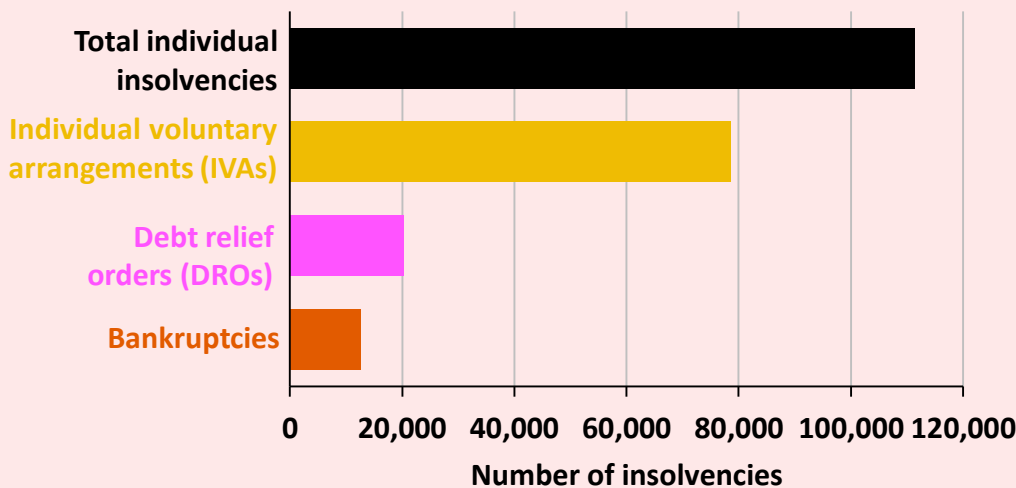




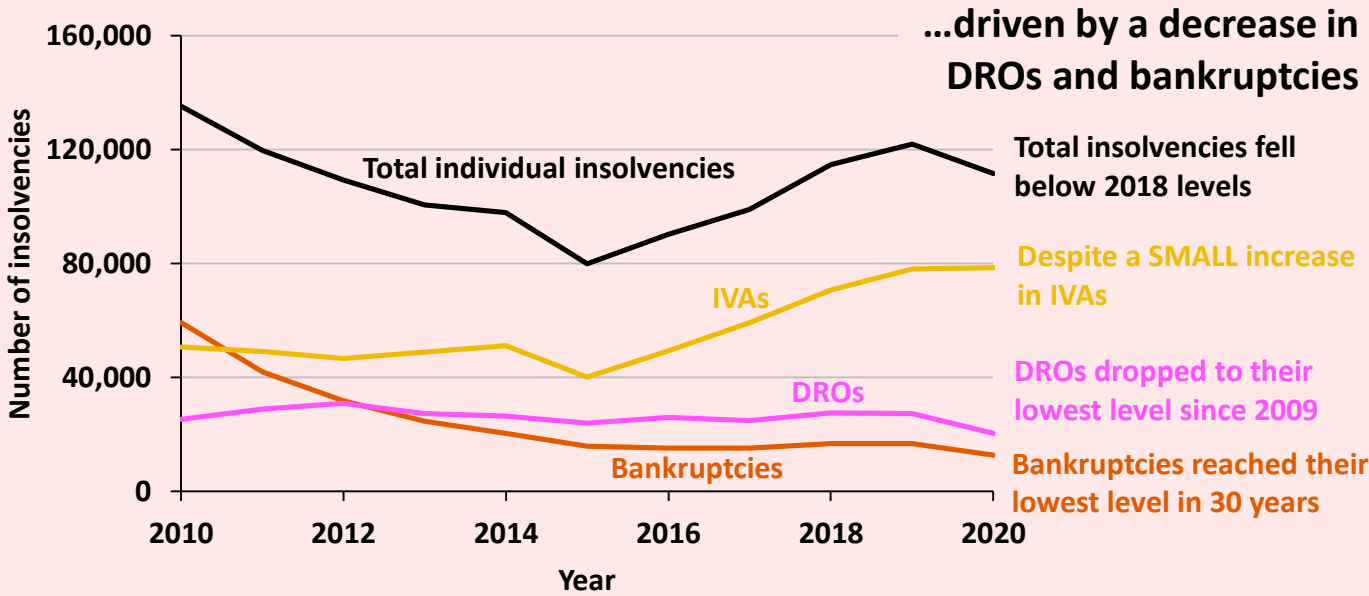
2020 Individual Insolvency Statistics England & Wales



Total individual insolvencies decreased to the lowest annual level since 2017...

In 2020, 1 in 420 adults became insolvent
(2019: 1 in 381)



Individual insolvencies have been low since the first UK lockdown on 23rd March 2020 in response to the coronavirus (COVID 19) pandemic. Lower numbers of insolvencies were likely to have been driven, at least in part, by Government fiscal and other measures put in place to support businesses and individuals.
