Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

First Claimant (Mr S Morris)

1. The Claimant's complaints of failing to make a redundancy payment, unlawful deductions from wages, unpaid holiday pay and breach of contract relating to notice succeed and he is awarded the following compensation;
 - a. Redundacy pay; £2,271.65
 - b. Wages; £2,187.50
 - c. Holiday pay; £151.44
 - d. Notice pay; £959.14

Second Claimant (Mrs S Morris)

 - b. Wages; £607.92
 - c. Holiday pay; £42.09
 - d. Notice pay; £687.42
