JUDGMENT MADE AT PRELIMINARY HEARING

- 1. The claimant complains of unfair dismissal under section 94 of the Employment Rights Act 1996.
- 2. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years' service to make an unfair dismissal complaint.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the claimant is not entitled to bring these proceedings.
- 5. The claimant has been given the opportunity to provide a reason as to why the complaint should not be struck out but has not provided any such reason.
- 6. The claimant has also not presented any facts from which a complaint of unfair dismissal under section 104 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 could be pursued.
- 7. Accordingly, the claim is struck out.
