## ANTICIPATED ACQUISITION BY UBER INTERNATIONAL B.V., A WHOLLY OWNED SUBSIDIARY OF UBER TECHNOLOGIES, INC., OF GPC COMPUTER SOFTWARE LIMITED AND ITS SUBSIDIARIES (AUTOCAB)

Termination of extension of the initial period mentioned in section 34ZA(1) of the Enterprise Act 2002 (the Act) published pursuant to section 107(1)(ac) of the Act

On 29 January 2021 the Competition and Markets Authority (**CMA**) gave notice under section 34ZA(3) of the Act that the initial period in relation to the anticipated acquisition by Uber International B.V., a wholly owned subsidiary of Uber Technologies, Inc., of GPC Computer Software Limited and its subsidiaries had commenced.

On 1 February 2021 the CMA published a notice to extend the initial period because GPC Computer Software Limited (**Autocab**) had not complied with a requirement set out in a notice under section 109 of the Act (the **Notice**) to provide certain information.

The CMA is now satisfied for the purposes of section 34ZB(7)(a) of the Act that the information has been provided as required by the Notice. This means that the end of the initial period is now 29 March 2021.
