## **JUDGMENT**

The Judgement of the Employment Tribunal is that:

- 1. At the material time (between 11 and 22 February 2019) the claimant was a disabled person for the purposes of section 6 of the Equality Act 2010 by reason of the mental impairment of anxiety and depression.
- 2. The respondent had constructive knowledge of the claimant's disability at the material time.
- 3. The claimant's claim that the respondent treated her less favourably than it treated or would treat others stands dismissed.

4. The claimant's claim that the respondent treated her unfavourably for something arising in consequence of disability stands dismissed.
