- (a) The birds comprising the flock(s) of origin have been inspected and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious disease:

(b) in so far as can be determined there has been no evidence of the following diseases at the flock(s) of origin during the past 6 months:

**fowl pox, fowl cholera, ornithosis/psitacosis, infectious avian encephalomyelitis, or mycoplasmosis (chronic respiratory disease);**

(c) during collection of the eggs for export or collection of the eggs for hatching the day old poults for export, the parent flocks(s) of the day old poults/hatching eggs have not been treated or fed with any natural or synthetic hormonal substances, antibiotics, or toxic substances carcinogenic or otherwise, which exceed European Union maximum permitted levels;

(d) the flock(s) of origin are members of a government supervised poultry health scheme and are considered officially free from: **Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum, Salmonella arizonae, Mycoplasma gallisepticum and Mycoplasma meleagridis.**
