## JUDGMENT

### Rule 21 of Schedule 1 to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013

#### Response

1. The Respondent has stated that no part of the claim is contested. Judgment is entered in favour of the Claimant as follows.

#### Redundancy Payment

2. The Claimant is entitled to a redundancy payment of £1,664.  
(4 years x £416 per week)

#### Notice Pay

3. The Claimant is entitled to notice pay of £1,664.  
(4 years x £416 per week)

#### Holiday Pay

4. The Claimant is entitled to holiday pay of £2,080.  
(5 weeks x £416 per week)

#### Total

5. The total of the above awards is **£5,408** and the Respondent is ordered to pay this sum to the Claimant.
