1. The Respondent has stated that no part of the claim is contested. Judgment is entered in favour of the Claimant as follows.

## **Redundancy Payment**

2. The Claimant is entitled to a redundancy payment of £1,664. (4 years x £416 per week)

#### **Notice Pay**

3. The Claimant is entitled to notice pay of £1,664. (4 years x £416 per week)

#### **Holiday Pay**

4. The Claimant is entitled to holiday pay of £2,080. (5 weeks x £416 per week)

#### **Total**

5. The total of the above awards is £5,408 and the Respondent is ordered to pay this sum to the Claimant.
