## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: READING ROAD INCIDENTS.**

We refer to your email dated 10 December 2020 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the same day.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

**“You say that there has been 280 incidents along Reading Road since 2015. May I have a list of those? I wouldn’t need details as such – for example (3 March20?? – car road traffic incident 18:52pm) that would be enough. I live on Reading Road, and I am trying to make the road safer, so any information is valuable to my cause. West Berkshire Council/Thames Valley Police say that there has only been two incidents in nine years! There is sometimes two a week! Lets go from January 1, 2018 to December 31 2018.”**

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
