DIRECTIONS

UPON the Appellants' application for directions dated 10 February 2021 under Rule 10 of The Energy Code Modification Rules (CC10) ('the Rules')

AND UPON hearing the parties at the case management conference in these proceedings held remotely on 11 February 2021

AND UPON the parties having agreed the terms of these Directions

AND HAVING REGARD TO the CMA's case management powers under Rule 10 of the Rules

IT IS DIRECTED THAT:

- These Directions become effective in respect of each of SSE Generation Limited and the entities listed in the Schedule to these Directions, the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority, National Grid Electricity System Operator Limited and Centrica plc and British Gas Trading Limited.

- 3. By 5pm on 25 February 2021 the Respondent shall file with the CMA and serve on the other parties its skeleton argument.
- 4. Each skeleton shall be no more than 20 pages in length and shall identify the nature of the argument in relation to the points in issue, identify propositions of law involved with reference to authority, and identify relevant submissions of fact with reference to the evidence.
- 5. There be liberty to apply.
