

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
England: cases by specimen date, patients in hospital and deaths within 28 days of positive test by date of death



Caveat: Testing capacity has increased since the first peak which has had a large effect on the number of cases recorded. This also has an impact on the data on deaths and to a lesser extent patients in hospital.

UK: Monthly Gross Domestic Product




UK: Unemployment Rate

UK: Adult depression and anxiety levels compared to pre-pandemic averages






Proportion (%) of population vaccinated in comparator countries

Cumulative number of COVID-19 Vaccinations Administered in the UK by Date Reported





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


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
ONS prevalence estimates of people testing positive for COVID-19 (England only) January through to mid February




ONS prevalence estimates of Kent (B117) variant compared to wild type since emergence








NHS admissions and occupancy between peaks





England: Total new COVID-19 incidents recorded in care homes



England: Deaths involving COVID-19 of care home residents



England: Percentage of residents and staff of older adult care homes vaccinated (first dose) by region










UK: Mean number of social contacts over time by age group

UK: Mobility in retail and recreation locations across lockdowns




London Underground usage compared across lockdowns




Weekly count of fixed penalty notices issued by Police in England to Individuals


GB: Percentage of workers who travelled to work in the last 7 days








GB: Percentage of adults avoiding physical contact when outside their home in the past seven days



relative output level, Feb 2020 = 100






Business sector activity and trading status

ONS Business Impacts of Coronavirus Survey: % of all businesses temporarily closed or paused trading








UK labour market support schemes






Percentage of eligible jobs furloughed by sector

Unemployment rate by ethnicity




Share of population reporting they are on furlough by income bracket


Unemployment rate change by nations and regions



Waves 1 and 2 mortality by ethnic group for men






Waves 1 and 2 mortality by ethnic group for women








Access to healthcare for long term health conditions in Great Britain by disability status, 24 September to 4 October 2020





Class access to internet and devices for remote learning by deprivation quintile




Percentage of pupils who are at or above age-related learning expectations: autumn 2019, summer 2020 and autumn 2020

Total first doses administered by region




Vaccination Doses Administered in England

OpenSafely Data: Percentage of 80+ Population Receiving Vaccine




% Population Administered at Least One Dose
