## JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim for unlawful deduction of wages, insofar as it concerns an alleged failure to pay wages for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> September 2017 is concerned, fails.
- 2. The Claimant's claim for breach of contract, concerning an alleged failure to pay notice pay, fails.
- 3. The Claimant's claim for unlawful deduction of wages, insofar as it concerns a failure to pay SEN allowance, is well founded and succeeds.
- 4. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant unpaid wages in the net sum of £1,815.30, payable by 19/02/2021.
